Bill's & Mainspring is to help homeless people obtain a home by giving temporary food and shelter, finding safe and affordable housing, and providing permanent housing with supportive services. In addition, we will be supporting Hingham Food Pantry with many of their urgent needs.

We need your help. Lunches will consist of a sandwich, chips, fruit, small treat, and a juice bag or a bottle of water. Lunches will be delivered to the shelter after school by SPS volunteers and distributed the following morning to shelter residents.
