Dear Saint Paul School Families,

Another full week at Saint Paul School: Fall afterschool enrichment started, NWEA testing, Book Fair, two Curriculum Nights, and band instrument lesson presentation!

NWEA testing for Kindergarten through Grade 7 is off to a great start! Please continue to monitor our testing schedule and remind students to take their time and that the test is not a race to be completed first.



There were 21 **fall afterschool enrichment** offerings with over 140 slots filled by students. If you were too late in registering, no worries as the next session will start the first week of November. You can expect the course offerings to made available mid-October.

Curriculum Nights are really the only time I have close to 100% of our parent population in one space at the same time. I thank each of you for taking the time to brave my yearly speech of reminders and initiatives for our special school.

Thank you to Mary Kerrigan and her team of parent volunteers for running a successful **book fair**! It is so nice to see the enjoyment of students purchasing books to read.

Band Lesson - Student Supervision on Thursday's -What a wonderful presentation from the Paul Effman Music Company on Wednesday! The students were all engaged and many are eager to take lessons - this is great news for Saint Paul School!

An added feature for our students AND parents - Band students waiting to take lessons will be supervised by a SPS faculty member. The students who are waiting for their lesson will wait in a classroom and do homework. Parents will be required to pick-up students following their assigned lesson. For a fee, extended day care will be made available, if needed.

Please remember registration forms are due back Tuesday, September 27. Once we have the schedule of times / lesson groups more information will be provided regarding supervision.

Friday, September 30 is a **NO SCHOOL** Day for students. Teachers will be attending professional development titled *Forming Disciples in Mission:A Workshop in School-Based Evangelization*. During this day, teachers will: Understand the history and definition of Evangelization and the New Evangelization, Reflect on their individual journeys of discipleship and plan to grow in living as an intentional disciples of Jesus Christ, Become comfortable using personal witness to Christ in and out of the classroom, Evaluate and assist their students and others in their journeys of discipleship, and Understand and implement a vision for evangelizing schools and classrooms focused on discipleship.


