NJHS Induction Ceremony. He is a 1988 graduate of Saint Paul School - attending SPS from PreK - Grade 8.

Mr. MacLeod grew up in Hingham and Cohasset where he enjoyed playing town sports and loved everything about growing up near the ocean. His grandfather was a "private" pilot and he often took him flying as a child. His parents took him and his sister, Maura (SPS '94) on many trips around the world and these experiences set in motion his desire to fly airplanes and to see the world!

After 10 exciting years at SPS, Mr. MacLeod then attended BC High, where he was actively involved as a member of the National Honor Society, Varsity Football Team and the Key Society. During his Senior year, Mr. MacLeod received his FAA Private Pilot's Certificate and graduated in 1992. He then attended Boston College and graduated with a BS in Chemistry in 1996. During college MacLeod was also a cadet in the Reserve Officer Training Candidate Detachment at Boston University and was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant upon graduation. After college graduation he served in the United States Air Force for 10 years where he flew many types of aircraft. He was stationed in bases in Mississippi, Arizona, North Carolina and in South Korea. Mr. MacLeod had two deployments to the Middle East and flew combat sorties over Iraq and Afghanistan. While in the Air Force he graduated from many specialized flying and pilot schools and he currently holds the rank of Lieutenant Colonel. Mr. MacLeod continues his service in the military as an Air National Guardsman at Otis Air Force Base in Cape Cod as a wing staff officer.

For the last 10 years Mr. MacLeod had been a First Officer airline pilot for Southwest Airlines flying Boeing 737 airplanes. In his spare time he enjoys traveling, skiing, SCUBA diving and exploring the coastal shores of Massachusetts with his wife, Liz, and two children Shannon (gr 5) and Connor (gr 3).

We thank Mr. Macleod for his continued service to our country and sharing his interesting experiences and motivating words with our students at this year's NJHS ceremony.

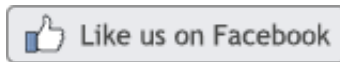
