

Our School

- Saint Paul School offers a highly structured academic program using standards-based curriculum and small class sizes.
- The academic curriculum is coordinated from Preschool through Grade 8 and while it is Common Core aligned, we follow a classical form of teaching.
- Our Early Childhood Learning Programs provides a structured, educational program with a curriculum that is based on developmentally appropriate practice and flexible options for enrollment.
- Aside from core subjects like reading, writing, math, social studies and science, students in all grades also develop a variety of skills in specialized classes including music, art, library, information technology and physical education.
- **Spanish** is taught for grades Preschool – Grade 8.
- Our Middle School students have the opportunity to participate in a language immersion program, and recently toured **Barcelona, Spain**.
- Our Middle School students also have the option to attend excursions each spring to New York City, Philadelphia or Washington DC.
- **Latin** elective is offered to Grade 7 and Grade 8 students.
- We engage in **community partnerships** with Holly Hill Farm, the Weston Observatory, Boston College, and Weir River Farm.
- Saint Paul School is registered as a “**Green School.**” As part of this initiative, we have an organic, edible garden used in the school lunch program, we maintain an on-site composter, and we use environmentally friendly products in the cleaning and maintenance of our facilities.

Our Students

- Saint Paul School has consistently produced the top standardized test scores in the Archdiocese of Boston.
- Saint Paul students regularly qualify for the **Johns Hopkins University Center for Talented Youth Program** based on high standardized test scores
- Saint Paul students compete annually in Plymouth Law Day: Essay and Poster Competitions. Over the past five years, Saint Paul students have finished 1st or 2nd in both categories every year.
- Saint Paul School students partner with local charities and raise **more than \$5,000** annually through community service projects.

Our Graduates

- **100%** of our graduates have been accepted into private and Catholic High Schools such as: Boston College HS, Notre Dame Academy, Catholic Memorial, Archbishop Williams HS, Cardinal Spellman HS, Noble and Greenough School, Thayer Academy, Milton Academy, Fontbonne Academy, Montrose School, Dexter Southfield Academy, Buckingham Browne and Nichols, St. Sebastian’s, Xaverian Brother High School Academy, and Northfield Mount Hermon.
- **85%** of graduates place into Honors and Advanced curriculum programs (including Algebra, English and Spanish) in high school
- Saint Paul graduates receive scholarships to Catholic High Schools and local, state and national recognitions based on their outstanding academic records, exemplary High School Placement Test scores and extraordinary leadership activity.

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
