- Blest Are We Religion Series

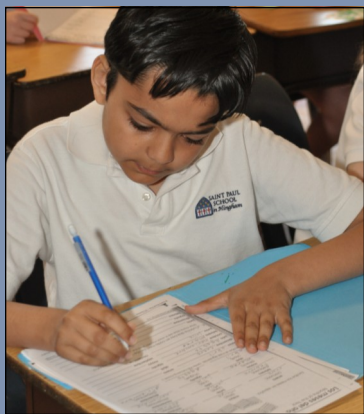
