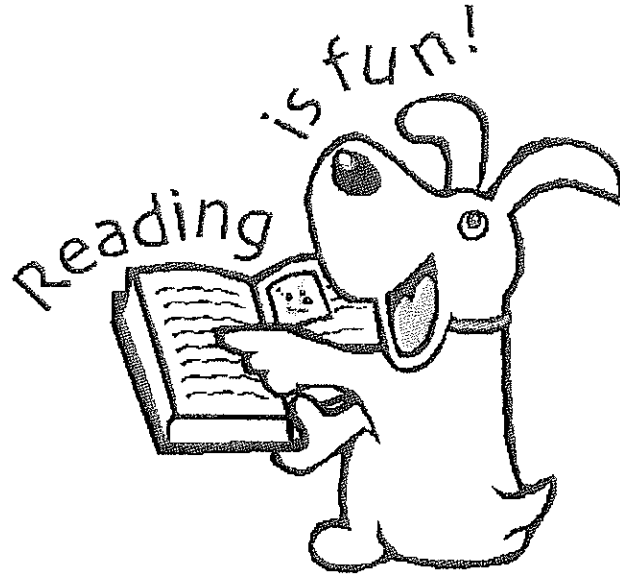
Dear Second Grade Parents,

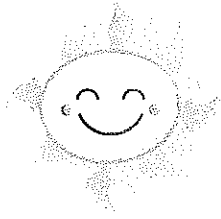
