  - Create a character sketch poster
  - Your poster should focus on four characters from this story.
  - Include a large, detailed drawing of four characters.
  - Next to each character's picture, write several quotes from the book that reflect the characters' personalities.
  - Your poster will be graded on accuracy of information, how well you understand the characters, and neatness.
  - Don't forget to include your name, title, and author.
  - Your poster will count as a test grade.

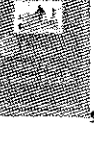

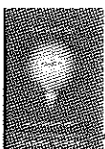
